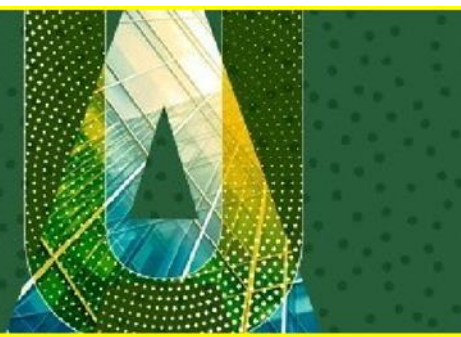

The Executive Certificate in Municipal Leadership (ECML) is a unique professional development and capacity-building program designed specifically for municipal leaders across Alberta, and Canada. The program builds on over 20 years of successful delivery via the Certificate in Municipal Management & Leadership (CMML). The ECML continues to be included within the Alberta School of Business Executive Education Unit and has evolved to become the first blend of non-credit and for-credit accreditation offered by the University of Alberta.

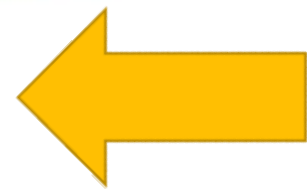


This tool enables Continuing Education students to enroll into non-credit Online and Continuing Education classes. It cannot be used to register into undergraduate or graduate classes.

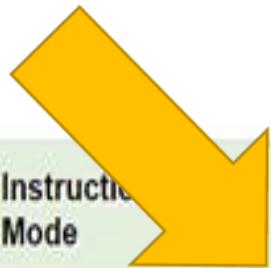

▼ EXASB 6101 - Leading and Managing in Municipalities

Course begins with emotional intelligence self-identification; how beliefs, values, and principles impact leadership. Participants will complete an emotional intelligence assessment (EQi) with integration of outcomes. Strategic thinking will also be explored as a compelling way to explore the future of municipalities; going deeper than frameworks into the thought processes that allow effective strategy to form. Participants will learn by doing; using individual and group activities reflective of municipal challenges.

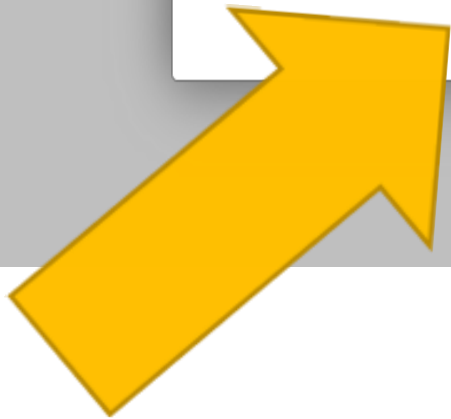
